2. **Date Page:** Complete the review sheet.

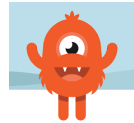
3. **Word Study/Reading:**

1. **Online Learning:** Join the online teaching google meet 9-10. Bring your daily work papers and whiteboard.

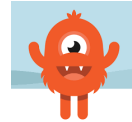
2. **Date Page:** Complete the review page.
