We are off to another great start to a week of virtual learning. Students are doing a wonderful job participating in our live sessions, as well as completing their work on Seesaw. I love seeing all of the creative ways that students show their thinking online. A reminder that all of this work is taken into consideration on students' report cards, so it is important that they try their best with all activities! So far, we are doing great with this!

There are a few important things to note for this week:

- **On Thursday, May 20**, we will be having a Show and Tell. In French, it is called *Montre et Raconte*. Students will choose an important item in their home to share with the class. They will prepare an oral piece to tell us about their item in French. We will practice various "sharing statements" throughout the week to get ready! I encourage students to choose their item early, so that it is not left to the last minute!
- **Friday, May 21** will be another Theme Day! This week our theme will be Crazy Colors. Students are encouraged to come wearing bright and flashy colors to celebrate the end of the week!
- We will have another BINGO Game on **Friday**, from **11 am - 12 pm**. If your child is interested in playing, **please let me know by Thursday**. I will send the game information on Thursday night.

This week, we are going to try to access **Ensemble Chez Nous**. This is a fantastic reading resource for students. There are many books that match the current reading levels of our students. 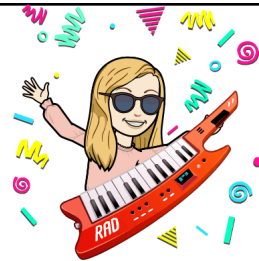
Monday, May 17/lundi, le 17 mai, 2021

Seesaw Activities:

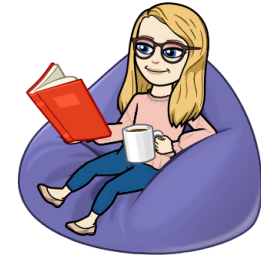
1. **Aller! Aller!** After learning about this new verb in our live session, students will complete the verb conjugation activity.

3. **Free Verse Poetry:** Students will rewatch the video on Free Verse Poetry to refresh their memory if needed. They will then try their hand at writing a Free-Verse poem!

Students will join Mlle for the Live Session from 9:00 - 10:30 am.



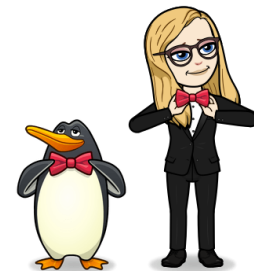
Seesaw Activities:

1. **Les Reliefs:** We have begun learning about different landforms in French. Students will complete the matching activity to show their understanding of different landforms. Need help? The presentation shown during our Live Session is attached for reference.
2. **Les Fractions:** Which fraction is bigger? Students will complete the activity, showing their understanding about denominators.
3. **Reading Time!** Grab a book and get cozy! Read for at least twenty minutes. In your Journal, write one connection you have with your story. Remember, the three types of connections are:
 - **Text to Self**
 - **Text to Text**
 - **Text to World**

Défi du Jour/Challenge of the Day (optional): Go for a walk in your neighbourhood. Give Mlle some Sensory details about what you saw, heard, smelled or touched! Give me lots of detail :)

Wednesday, May 19/mercredi, le 19 mai, 2021

Students will join Mlle for the Live Session from 9:00 - 10:30 am.



Seesaw Activities:

1. **Les Reliefs:** Students will think of the landforms that can be found in their community. In this activity, they will name each landform and give an example of one in their area.
2. **Ordering Fractions:** Students will show what they have learned from our Live Session to order fractions from smallest to biggest.
3. **Ode to an Ode:** Check out the video on Odes. Try writing one yourself!

Défi du Jour/Challenge of the Day (optional): Go outside and take a look at the clouds. What shapes or figures do you see? Imaginations are wonderful things! Take a picture of the sky or draw what you see in your Drawing Pad.

Thursday, May 20./jeudi, le 20 mai, 2021

Students will join Mlle for the Live Session from 9:00 - 10:30 am.



Seesaw Activities:

1. **La Nature Chez Moi:** Students will read “La Nature Chez Moi” on Ensemble Chez Nous. They will then answer the questions about the story they read. Use FULL sentences please :)
2. **Où sont les Fractions?** Look around your home to find examples of fractions. Fractions are everywhere if you look hard enough. This assignment will challenge you to get creative and use your math brain. Take a picture of what you find and upload it to Seesaw.
3. **Sudoku:** Try solving a sudoku puzzle! They are great exercise for the brain. Read the instructions on how to solve one to become a sudoku master!
4. **Montre et Rencontre reflection:** Students will complete the reflection on their Show and Tell presentation from the Live Session. See the guiding questions on Seesaw!

Défi du Jour/Challenge of the Day (optional): Build a fort (inside or out)! If you build it inside, use blankets, pillows and other household items. If you build it outside, use natural materials like logs, sticks or rocks. Take a picture of you in your fort and upload the picture on SeeSaw.

Friday, May 21/vendredi, le 21 mai, 2021

Students will join Mlle for the Live Session from 9:00 - 10:30 am.



Seesaw Activities:

1. **Radio Canada:** Take 10-15 minutes (or longer if you wish) to explore Radio-Canada: Zone Jeunesse. This is an excellent website and resource to practice listening, reading and speaking in

French. After you have explored the website, tell me:

- Three things that you did, watched or read
- Two things that you liked about the website
- One question you have about what you heard, saw or read on the site.

2. **Dessin de Fraction:** Students will follow the directions to complete the Fraction activity.
